



Advanced Placement Updates

Instruction Guidelines for AP Teachers

AP teachers will need to determine any adjustments in their course instruction based on the test outlines for each AP course, considering what content has already been covered and what still needs to be taught.

Using the district distance learning template AP teachers will plan weekly instruction for students and post this instruction within campus timelines.

Teachers should encourage each AP student to take part in the College Board AP review sessions beginning on Wednesday, March 25, 2020.

Teachers are encouraged to use the AP test question bank to create quizzes and other assessments for students.

Within AP Classroom, free-response questions that were only available for in-classroom use due to security concerns will now be unlocked. Teachers will be able to assign questions to students digitally and should consider student data available when assigning student work.

AP Review Courses

Wednesday, March 25, 2020, students will have access to free, live AP review lessons, delivered by AP teachers from across the country. These optional, mobile-friendly classes are designed to be used alongside work that may be given by schools.

These classes will also be available on-demand, so teachers and students can access them at any time.

The lessons will focus on reviewing the skills and concepts from approximately the first 75% of the yearlong courses and about half of the semester courses. There will also be some supplementary lessons covering the final 25% of the course.

AP Exam

All AP exams will be in an online, open book, open note format and 45 minutes in length.

All questions will be free response and students may be required to cite primary and secondary sources for responses. All questions will focus on application of learning through written response.

AP test outlines will include content to be tested on each exam. Students and teachers are encouraged to review these to prepare for the exam.

Online review sessions for each course will begin on March 25, 2020.

AP Exam dates and times have not been released yet by College Board. This information will be sent to students who have signed up for course exams as well as posted on the College Board website and the CCISD website.
